## **Profile Script.**

While writing your profile script, be honest and add a touch of humour. Make it interesting to the reader. Mention what you are passionate about and also things you really don't like, in a humorous way. Dating Sites usually give the opportunity to check the things you like or can't stand – eg "**Smoking**", "**Drinking alcohol**", "**Sports**", "**Reading**", "**Religion**" etc. Make sure you choose the ones that apply to you. If you lie about these options, you may be surprised that the only people who respond to your profile are the wrong ones.

## **Profile photos.**

If you are a woman, post decent photos of yourself. **Avoid putting up NUDE OR PARTIALLY NUDE PHOTOS on your profile.** They show you up as "loose" or "immoral". Also, post one or two pictures of you not wearing make-up. Guys know that women typically only post the very best and most glamorous pictures of themselves, so it's kind of hard to know what she really looks like first thing in the morning. If you take a picture of yourself when you're not in make-up, you'll still get responses. Most men want a REAL woman, anyway, not a mannequin.

If you are a man, putting up nude photos of yourself will put really serious-minded women off completely, particularly ladies who are looking for long-term partners or husbands. They prefer to get to know you first as a responsible and likeable "person", before wanting to know how big or small your "manhood" is, if you get my drift.

Also, put up other pictures of yourself in different parts of your life. For instance, if you like biking, post a picture of yourself on your bike, wearing your biking gear. Post a picture of you on vacation in your favourite spot. If you like going out at night, put up a picture of you wearing full make-up and dressed to

## **SCAMMERS.**

Some other male scammers use fake photos – photos of genuine white men found online and claiming to be them.

- i) **Catch them out by asking for direct phone calls with you – not Skype messaging or WhatsApp Message where they can use some fraudulent technology to dupe you of your money.**
- ii) **If they refuse to call you on your phone for a direct chat so you can hear how they sound, stop responding to their messages – change your email address and phone number!**
- iii) **Another note of warning: Don't let their 001... phone number fool you.** That number with an American code could be fake.

They are not American nor are they in America. They may have told you they are American Soldiers, Doctors, Pharmacists, etc and put fake photos of American men on their Profiles.

Request a Facetime chat on the phone with them.

- iv) **STOP contacting anyone who tells you a long and woeful story of how they need money for a flight ticket to visit you, to get their family member out of hospital or to pay a tax bill etc.** Remember, these are scammers, they will sweet-talk you into parting with your money. **DON'T BE FOOLED OR SCAMMED!**

## **FIRST MEET-UP**

If you have managed to find a genuine person who is interested enough to want to meet up with you, great! But where should you meet up? My suggestion is in a public place, and never in a seclude area, nor your place or his place. Meet up in a Restaurant, a Pub or any open place with many other people. And at the end of the meeting – GO HOME! Don't follow that person to their home. Then take some time to think about that person – your conversations, the vibes between the two of you – was there any “spark” between you? Do you think you might be compatible? The second and third meetings must also be in Public places. Never visit your new-found date in their own homes until you are sure you know their values and can trust them.

Always tell someone at home who you are going to see and give them that person's photograph and phone number to be safe.

As you try to talk to your partner about the latest book you've just finished reading, he's nodding at what you're saying but, at the same time, his eyes are glazing over. You know he's not really listening because he's actually bored to death.

Then, there's the area of activities. He may love to go camping in the wild, but your idea of camping is to stay at a rustic mountain cabin with all of the amenities. You may like to go hiking or biking, but he loves an afternoon of skydiving. Clearly, there are some vast differences in this area of your relationship.

If you were to ask your partner as a woman, why he is no longer as romantic as he was when you first started dating, I bet he would say, without even blinking, that: “It’s simply not fair to expect real flesh and blood men to act the way that a supernatural character in a book acts”.

Look for someone that you can get to know and someone that will want to know who you really are. There's so much more to a person than the way they look, and you cannot hope to know someone simply by looking at them.

## **Communication is Key.**

There must be talking and interacting. **Communication is key**. It is the only way to find out what you need to know about someone and tell if you want to be in a relationship with that person. It doesn't happen any other way. In fact, if you do try to pin it all on how attracted you are physically to someone, you'll find out just how disappointing a relationship can be in the end.

You already know that he isn't among the men that you are acquainted with so, now what? Online dating is "what".

## **Tools for Resolving Difficulties.**

### **The Importance of Communication.**

**I can't stress enough the importance of effective communication in helping to resolve difficulties in relationships.**

People communicate in different ways. Some people are naturally good communicators while others are not so blessed.

There are also differences in communication styles between extroverts and extroverts.

The most effective way of communicating with your partner is using the "**reflective listening technique**".

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## What is Reflective Listening?

Simply put, it is a communication style that effective parents use with their younger children.

If you tell your five-year-old how to cross the road on the way to school, you would possibly say it this way:

*You: John, remember to look left, and then look right before you cross the road. Make sure that all cars have stopped before you start crossing the road. Is that clear?*

*John: Yes, Mummy.*

*You: So what did I say to do at the Zebra Crossing before you cross the road?*

*John: Mum, you said once at the Zebra crossing, I must look left and then right, and only start crossing the road when all the cars have stopped moving and are waiting for me to cross.*

*You. Great, John! That's exactly right!*

You could say to me: ***"But Grace, we are not babies!"***

Yes, I get that. But the one thing that causes friction in adult relationships is the fact that the other partner is not always listening attentively when you speak to him or her. It takes patience and interest for you to listen to your partner. But if for some reason you or your partner is upset about sometime, it could be because of an issue at work, or something you said earlier, chances are that he or she may not have "heard" or "understood" what you said. So it is worth asking him/her to repeat what you said as they understood it.

If they get it right, fine, if not, repeat what you said earlier in a clearer way, so your partner understands you without any ambiguity.

**It sounds simple, but it does work. You don't want to risk getting misunderstood by your partner!**

**Use the “5 Love Languages” Suggested by Dr Gary Chapman.**

**1. “Words of Affirmation”.**

Find out if your partner likes your words of affirmation – like “I love you”. “You look great” and other complimentary statements like that. Use them often if that pleases him or her.

**2. “Quality Time”.**

Maybe your partner loves spending quality time with you. If that is case, make sure you create your “Together Time”, when it’s just the two of you together, talking, watching TV, or being out to watch a film, etc.

**3. “Giving of Gifts”.**

If your partner appreciates little gifts of love like flowers, occasional affectionate cards, or anything else, then make an effort to give him/her these gifts once in a while.

**4. “Acts of Service”.**

If your partner appreciates you doing some act of service for him/her, then do that as often as you can.

**5. “Physical Touch”.**

If touching is your partner’s way of feeling close to you, then make it a habit to touch him or her on the hand, shoulder, back, or wherever is

convenient – lightly. Give each other hugs regularly and add words of affirmation.

### **Issues arising from Non-Commitment.**


